IMPORTANT: READ THESE TERMS CAREFULLY:

Terms and Conditions:

- The license becomes effective once the Buyer goes to the following website – www.spotlightoncomprehension.com and registers for the product by entering the assigned access codes used by the teacher(s) and students. (The instructions for registering are included in the User Guide sent to the Buyer when the product gets shipped.)
- There are two types of Licenses identified by the item number that you purchased.
 - Classroom licenses are available for up to 40 students in a specific class and grade level.
 - Site licenses (which include use in bookrooms) are available for students enrolled at the building.
- Authorized Users are defined as yourself, any substitute teachers and/or teaching assistants, and students enrolled in your class. For an institution, Authorized Users are defined as students enrolled at your institution and teachers (including temporary staff for the duration of their assignment, staff members, and administrators employed by your institution. Licensed rights terminate automatically with any breach of licensing terms. Except as expressly licensed herein, all other rights in and to the digital files and their contents are hereby expressly reserved by Sundance/Newbridge LLC.
- Authorized Users may access the website from within your institution(s) or any other computer, including at home, for use in lessons, seminars, homework, individual study and any other reasonable pedagogic purpose.
- No broadcast or cablecast of video is permitted under this license.
